6 Neuroscience Research

Multi-tenant lab building with International Flavors & Fragrances as primary tenant. Inside this publicly traded company, scientists are creating the tastes and scents of food and beverages, home and personal care.

9 @4240 Duncan Avenue

Multi-tenant lab/office, home to Cortex Staff offices, CIC, global business AB Mauri, along with publicly traded companies and startups alike.

10 4220 Duncan Avenue

Multi-tenant lab/office, tenants include Microsoft, CIC, Boeing, Aon, Filament, WU/SLU COLLAB, and Move by BJC fitness.
